Federal	Changes to FWT and OASDI effective January 1, 2011 The federal withholding tables have been updated for 2011, including the change to OASDI For 2011 the employee tax rate for Social Security is 4.2% The Medicare rate is unchanged, The employer portion of SSI and Medicare are unchanged The withholding allowance amount has changed to \$3700 The Making Work Pay credit has expired, this is reflected in the new withholding tables

The State Filing status for all employees must be manually adjusted in order to ensure the correct filing status is assigned.

	"Single <3Allow >=\$50000" - Single employees with less than 3 allowances earning \$50000 or more per year; "Single >=3Allow >=\$50000" - Single employees with 3 or more allowances earning \$50000 or more per year; "Married >= \$50000 - Married employees earning \$50000 or more per year.

An error which created a blank part ID no longer occurs when editing a comment on a partially invoiced Sales Order

Duplicate line items are no longer created when editing a line item description on a partially invoiced Sales Order

Payroll checks with a check date in the current quarter and pay period start and end dates in the next quarter now appear correctly on the 941 report
